The position consists in a no-term contract employment, and provides for an initial evaluation upon recruitment and periodic evaluations.

Under the supervision of the Director of the Department of Anesthesia and Intensive Care, the Attending Anesthesiologist will manage the anesthesia of patients undergoing surgical or invasive procedures at IRCCS ISMETT.

He/she will be included in the on-call shifts of the operating room. On a rotation basis, he/she will work in the Intensive Care Unit and, according to service needs, will be available to be on-duty during night and holiday shifts in the ICU.

Requisites:

- Degree in Medicine and Surgery recognized in Italy or a legally equivalent degree from a foreign university.

- Previous training/professional experience in ICU and OR in Italy or abroad.
- Scientific production rated with the H-index.

Good English proficiency, knowledge of main computer applications, availability to spend training periods abroad, high motivation, flexibility, stress management, problem-solving skills, good interpersonal, communication, and teamwork skills are also instrumental to the role.
