UPMC Italy offers professional opportunities in an international and multicultural setting at IRCCS ISMETT (Istituto Mediterraneo per i Trapianti e Terapie ad Alta Specializzazione), one of the most innovative and technologically-advanced Italian medical facilities, managed by UPMC (University of Pittsburgh Medical Center) in partnership with Civico Hospital and the Ri.MED Foundation.

The Physician in the Office of the Director of Health Care Activities follows the latter's directions in order to ensure compliance with health care regulations, manage medical and legal matters related to disputes, promote environmental safety, and prevent incidents and hospital infections.

Other operational scopes and tasks include: quality of care; identifying and promoting innovative management and organizational models to provide efficient and effective response to the patients' needs; drafting and reviewing policies and procedures for staff and patient health and safety; JCI (Joint Commission International) accreditation.

Requisites:

- Degree in Medicine and Surgery recognized in Italy, or equivalent title.
- Postgraduate school diploma in Hygiene and Hospital Service Organization or in Legal and Insurance Medicine, or equivalent title.
- Post-graduate seniority of at least 3 years.

Preferential qualifications:

- Training courses in Health Care Management.
- Scientific production rated with the H-index.
- Professional or training experience in a Director of Health Care Activities' Office in Italy or abroad.

Good English proficiency, familiarity with the main computer applications, communication and interpersonal skills, organizational skills, problem-solving, flexibility, and stress management complete the profile.

UPMC Italy reserves its right of discretion to the fullest extent permitted by law in assessing the candidates and the eligibility of the applications.

Only applicants who are not excluded under the provisions articulated in Legislative decree 165/2001, Art. 53, para. 16-ter, as amended and supplemented (General Rules Governing the Work of Public Administrations - <http://www.upmcitaly.it/wp-content/uploads/2017/01/Art-ENG.pdf>) can participate in this selection.

After reading the privacy statement and authorizing the processing of their personal data (Legislative decree 196/2003), applicants of either sex (Law 196/2003) are requested to fill

When filling out the on-line application form, applicants will be requested to attach their CV. Candidates are also requested to attach a motivation letter and a list of their scientific publications.

At the end of the on-line process, applicants will be requested to state, by means of self-declaration, that they possess the requirements listed under this call for applications.

All communications from UPMC Italy will be sent via e-mail to the address given by the applicant upon submission of the application.

The deadline to submit applications is **March 15, 2018**.

Only applications submitted on-line (<http://selezioni.upmcitaly.it>) and accompanied by a CV will be taken into consideration.

Under penalty of exclusion, all applicants are obliged to provide the documentation demonstrating the possession of the requisites stated in the self-certification, whenever UPMC Italy requires it during the selection process and within the fixed mandatory deadline. Should any preliminary verification show a discrepancy with any statement submitted by the applicant, the latter will be excluded from the selection process, and any negotiation deemed permanently suspended.

Personal data included in the CV will be processed by UPMC Italy and IRCCS ISMETT for selections referring to this or other similar positions. Applicants are requested not to include sensitive data (e.g., health status), unless strictly necessary.
