## 1 Pneumologist (Ref. Pneumo/18)

UPMC Italy offers professional opportunities in an international and multicultural setting at IRCCS ISMETT (Istituto Mediterraneo per i Trapianti e le Terapie ad alta specializzazione), one of the most state-of-the-art and technologically-advanced Italian clinical facilities, managed by UPMC (University of Pittsburgh Medical Center), Civico Hospital, and Fondazione Ri.MED.

The position consists in a no-term contract, and provides for an initial evaluation upon recruitment followed by periodic assessments. The selected candidate will be responsible for coordinating the Pulmonology Service's clinical activity for lung transplants, respiratory failure and rare lung diseases in collaboration with the Thoracic Surgery and Lung Transplantation Unit, while at the same time following training programs and conducting clinical research.

## **Requisites:**

- Degree in Medicine and Surgery recognized in Italy, or a legally equivalent title.
- Postgraduate diploma in Diseases of the Respiratory System recognized in Italy, or a legally equivalent title.
- Enrollment in the board of physicians.

The ideal candidate has extended experience in selecting lung transplant candidates, postlung transplant clinical follow-up, performing diagnostic endoscopy for diagnosis of postlung transplant complications, staging pulmonary solid lesions, managing adult patients with cystic fibrosis, pulmonary hypertension and pulmonary fibrosis and has a knowledge of the principles for use of veno-venous extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO).

## Preferential qualifications:

- Several years of experience as a pneumologist in lung transplant programs activated in Italian, European, or U.S. transplant centers.
- Documented research (clinical trials) in the field of pneumology.
- Documented mentorship for physicians on training.
- Participation in patient care quality improvement programs in the respiratory field.
- Scientific production rated with the H-index.
- Excellent knowledge of English.
