1 Biomedical Monitoring Researcher (Ref. Biomonitor/19)

ISMETT (Istituto Mediterraneo per i Trapianti e le Terapie ad Alta Specializzazione) is a state-of-the-art and one of the most technologically-advanced hospitals in Italy, managed by UPMC (University of Pittsburgh Medical Center) in partnership with Civico Hospital and the Ri.MED Foundation. The Italian Ministry of Health acknowledged ISMETT as an Institute for scientific-based care and treatment (IRCCS) in the area of “End-stage organ failure treatment and research.”

Within the scope of the project “*Sistemi innovativi di precisione per la prevenzione e la gestione delle patologie correlate agli stili di vita - LifeStyle4Health*” (F/050408/02/X32) funded by the Italian Ministry of Economic Development, IRCCS-ISMETT is issuing a call for applications for the selection of 1 Biomedical Monitoring Researcher. The Researcher carries out tasks related to the analysis, processing and monitoring of biomedical data for the Lifestyle4Health project. The duration of the contract will depend on the length of the project.

Requisites:

All applicants are expected to possess the following requisites at the time of application:

- Master's degree in Biological Sciences, Biotechnologies, Pharmacy, Pharmaceutical Technology and Chemistry (or equivalent titles recognized in Italy).
- PhD in the biomedical field.

Preferred qualifications:

- Specialization in biomedical field.
- Previous experience in this role.
- Scientific production rated with the H-index.

The ideal candidate has a proven experience in implementing and assessing molecular biology research activities, from storing to processing samples to be analyzed or reagents to be prepared. Furthermore, he/she has the ability to analyze and critically process the obtained experimental data, also referring to the most recent scientific literature within the framework of the project, and to collaborate to the improvement of the quality of research activities.

Strong motivation, flexibility, stress management, problem-solving skills, and good interpersonal, communication and teamwork skills complete the role.

The activity will take place in Palermo.
