ISMETT (Istituto Mediterraneo per i Trapianti e le Terapie ad Alta Specializzazione) is a state-of-the-art and one of the most technologically-advanced hospitals in Italy, managed by UPMC (University of Pittsburgh Medical Center) in partnership with Civico Hospital and the Ri.MED Foundation. The Italian Ministry of Health acknowledged ISMETT as an Institute for scientific-based care and treatment (IRCCS) in the area of "End-stage organ failure treatment and research."

Under the supervision of the head of pathology services, the Pathology Lab Technician will manage cytohistology tests for diagnostic, educational and research purposes, performing and recording all the activities according to the main pathology diagnostic techniques.

Preferred qualifications:

Documented experience in the execution of: small biopsy inclusions and cytological preparations, needle biopsy cryostat sectioning, small biopsy microtome sectioning, routine, histochemical and immunohistochemical staining.

The ideal candidate is also familiar with the analytical methods of modern pathology laboratories, including molecular analysis methods and digital pathology applications. He/she has experience with routine maintenance of the instruments used for pathology diagnostic and research applications, and with the management of reagent storage. He/she is familiar with the use of computer applications generally used in pathology laboratories. Good knowledge of English and use of main computer applications. Good organizational, time and stress management, and interpersonal skills, accuracy, and critical thinking complete the profile.
