The ideal candidate should demonstrate superior planning abilities and have significant people and project management expertise.

S/he should have previous experience in managing design and construction professionals, selecting and appointing vendors, consultants and contractors, and have excellent oral and written communication skills. The Senior Project Manager will work in an established team and cooperate with other managers. The successful candidate will be responsible to ensure that assigned facility design, renovation and construction projects are successfully executed using available resources.

The ideal candidate possesses the following:

- University degree in Architecture or Civil, Mechanical, or Electrical Engineering. Master's degree preferred
- Enrollment in the Board of Architecture or Engineering.
- At least 15 years of documented experience in the management of design, renovation and construction projects.
- At least 7 years of documented experience in the planning, construction and commissioning of capital expenditure projects and knowledge of current Italian regulations on designing and constructing facilities in a clinical setting.
- At least 5 years of documented supervisory/leadership experience in the management and development of engineering and construction management professionals.
- Documented previous experience working independently, or with a formal engineering team, on large projects, in health care and/or research .
- Fluent in Italian and English, written and oral.

Multitasking, proactivity, reliability, stress management, problem solving, teamwork and strong interpersonal skills as well as availability to travel are also instrumental to the role.

The contract offered will be commensurate with the experience and skills of the selected candidate.

The workplace is **Rome** but travel throughout Italy will be required. Overseas travel may be required.
