is issuing a Job Posting for the following *fixed-term* position:

1 Junior Developer (Ref. SJ/19 TD)

ISMETT (Istituto Mediterraneo per i Trapianti e le Terapie ad Alta Specializzazione) is a state-of-the-art and one of the most technologically-advanced hospitals in Italy, managed by UPMC (University of Pittsburgh Medical Center) in partnership with Civico Hospital and the Ri.MED Foundation. The Italian Ministry of Health acknowledged ISMETT as a Scientific Institute for Research and Health Care (IRCCS) in the area of “End-stage organ failure treatment and research.”

The Junior Developer (JD) develops software for Information System Integrations, also providing Information and Communication Technology applications and solutions complying with the specific mandatory requirements. The JD is responsible for writing technical specifications and design characteristics, developing software on test environments, testing, implementing, and supporting the applications. Finally, the JD cooperates with system administrators and staff in providing support to users with troubleshooting on the developed systems.

Applicants must meet the requisites and preferred qualifications of this call when filing the application and state them in the on-line form.

Requisites:

- High School Diploma
- Documented work experience in software development (NET, Java, or other equivalent programming languages)

Preferred qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Information Technology, Mathematics, Engineering, Physics, or Statistics. (Please indicate the final mark in the on-line form).

The ideal candidate knows TCP/IP-based networks and the main programming and scripting languages. He/she has basic knowledge of IT infrastructures, development of web-based applications, and management of Windows, Linux, and SQL (store procedures and query) environments.

English proficiency, organizational skills, time and stress management, problem solving, interpersonal relationship, and team working skills are also instrumental to the role.

Only applicants not excluded under the provisions articulated in Legislative decree 165/2001, art. 53, para. 16-ter, and subsequent modifications and

amendments (General Rules Governing the Work of Public Administrations https://www.ismett.edu/wp-content/uploads/2017/12/Note-esplorative-allArt.-53-comma-16-ter-D.Lgs.-Nr.-1652001-All-11_EN.docx) may attend this selection.
